I did debrief with her after both lessons for her to reflect on how she thought it went.

I feel that she could have adapted her lessons a bit more when she was working with small groups of students. The groups that she worked with were students that are about the same level (a very low group, a low group, an average group and a high group). She chose to teach her lesson the exact same way for each group, where this would have been a wonderful opportunity to adapt the lesson based on the needs of the students.
